Can I count on your help?

I am writing to ask for your help in circulating my nomination paper so my name will appear on the ballot for the General Election on November 2nd to run for the 5th Congressional seat in Wisconsin. The rules of the nomination process are exact and must be followed precisely so that your hard work will count. Please take a few moments and review the *Rules for Circulating Nomination Papers* found on the reverse side of this letter. One of the most important things to remember is that we **can only accept signatures gathered on or after June 1, 2010**. In addition, the Circulator must sign the paper **after** the electors on each paper have signed.

In order for my campaign to have time to review my nomination papers prior to submitting them, we ask that you mail the paper to us no later than June 28, 2010.

In addition, please complete the enclosed volunteer card and return it along with the nomination paper. This helps us tremendously.

This 2010 election is bound to be one of the most exciting in history. I am greatly enthused about the opportunities before us, and am honored to once again seek the nomination to represent the 5th Congressional District of Wisconsin. Be assured I will continue my fight in Washington to cut spending; curb the growth of our government; and find ways for taxpayers to keep their hard-earned dollars. With your help, I can continue. RULES FOR CIRCULATING NOMINATION PAPERS (PLEASE FOLLOW EXACTLY)

1. Do not circulate Nomination Papers until June 1, 2010. Any signatures dated prior to June 1st will be disqualified. The Circulator must sign the paper after the electors on each paper have signed.
2. Before circulating the nomination paper, please read it carefully. You must present the paper to each signer; you cannot leave the nomination papers unattended on counters or posted on billboards.
3. All signers must reside in the 5th Congressional District. A map and list of towns, cities and villages in the 5th District are printed on the back of the Nomination Paper.
4. The signers must use their exact municipality of residence rather than their mailing address, if different (i.e., Village of Whitefish Bay, not Milwaukee). Abbreviations such as “WB” for West Bend, for example, may disqualify the signer.
5. All signers must fill in their complete address and date of signature. If any heading is left blank, the signature is disqualified.
6. Circulator must complete the Certification of Circulator at the bottom of the nomination paper. Circulators must include their municipality, not postal address. See #4 above. **NOTE: Notarization of paper is no longer required.**
7. Please return the nomination paper by June 28th so it can be filed on time. If you cannot return a full sheet, please return a partial sheet with Certification of Circulator complete. Every signature helps.
